Competition Rules:

1. Entry is free.
2. Your poem can be about any theme; please keep in mind the poems are to be displayed in shop windows and may be read by children or adults.
3. The maximum number of lines per poem is **12**.
4. Your entry must be your original, unaided work.
5. Your entry may be handwritten or typed. Please use a separate sheet of paper for each poem and do not put your name or details on the sheets with your poem(s). (The poems are judged anonymously.)
6. You may not enter more than 2 poems.
7. Take or send your poem **with this entry form** to Dawlish Library or to Open Daw, Foyer Methodist Church, Brunswick Place, Dawlish EX7 9PB, or submit by email to:
poetry@dawlish.info
8. If submitting by email, please also supply your address and a contact phone number, and confirm that the poems are your own unaided work, and have not previously been published.
9. Entries must arrive no later than NOON on Friday 7th April 2017.
10. Unfortunately, we can't return your poems, so make sure you keep a copy for yourself.
11. Patricia Oxley MBE (a non-member of the Dawlish Poetry for Pleasure group) will select the poems to be used in the Poetry Trail and the prize winners.
12. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. Copyright will remain with the author(s), but Dawlish Arts Festival / Dawlish Poetry for Pleasure Group reserve the right to publish any of the winning poems either in print or online.
14. By entering the competition, entrants are deemed to have agreed that their names and their entries may be used by Dawlish Arts Festival in publicity material associated with the competition.
15. Poems selected for the trail and prize-winners will be announced on Sunday 21st May 2017 on the Poetry for Pleasure Dawlish Facebook page and in local media. The trail takes place from Saturday 27th May to Saturday 3rd June 2017.
